Yachting Experience

Aug 2024 & Jun 2022 – Croatia **First Mate to Captain** **Bavaria C46**

During a one-week sailing trip out of Zadar and a two-week round trip along the Croatian coast (Split to Dubrovnik), I assisted the captain with various duties to ensure smooth operations. My responsibilities included: aiding in passage planning and chart review to determine safe navigation routes and anchorages for overnight stops; mooring to buoys, docking the yacht, and ensuring fenders were properly positioned; preparing and lifting the sails, ensuring sheets and lines were appropriately in position for both sail and motor passages; helming the yacht for long periods of time; transporting guests to and from the shore; general boat maintenance, ensuring the vessel was in optimal condition throughout the trips.

Mar 2008 – Apr 2019 – Florida **Crew Mate** **Grady White Seafarer 228**

During family visits to the Southwest coast of Florida, I regularly took the helm of my grandfather's boat, using the chart plotter, navigating to remote beaches and islands, game fishing and docking. I also sailed a Sunfish dinghy in Matlacha Pass, gaining a further understanding of tides and wind. Additionally, I operated a small outboard boat through the mangroves, navigating shallow waterways and fishing for Red Snapper, Pompano, and sharks.

Within my university degree I studied the following relevant modules:

Marine Materials and Production Technology – based in the composite workshop, learning the process of laying up composite fibres such as Chop Strand Mat, Double Biaxial cloth, Carbon Fibre and many others. Delved further into composite and metal construction, marine paint technology, epoxy and gelcoat systems, and more advanced procedures for testing materials.

Naval Architecture – studying the stability of vessels; small angle and large angle stability, paired with Computer Aided Design and analysis of data taken from related problems and experiments.

Applied Marine Systems – gathered knowledge on systems such as: propulsion and how they operate, in more detail; propellers parameters and how to select the appropriate ones; fluid mechanics and piping systems; HVAC systems and finally, fire and manoeuvrability systems.

Yacht Surveying – tracing back problems to their origin. Appreciation of long-term issues and weaknesses associated with wood, FRP, steel and aluminium structures together with material specific fault types, methods of diagnosis and identification and rectification techniques.
